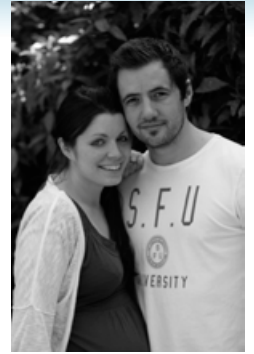


Impact

What?

A year-out volunteer project dedicated to serving the church, growing in your relationship with God and blessing Exeter. An opportunity to make a significant and lasting contribution to the life of Frontiers Church Exeter after completing your University degree. A year for you to discover and develop your gifting and put them to use in the local church.

Monthly training sessions with other Impact students from across the South-West which will equip you to think biblically and help you build your life on robust theological foundations. Modules include the Doctrine of Scripture, Worship, Spiritual Gifts and Church History.

An Impact year can take many guises. In the past we've seen Impact students write and record a worship album, develop preaching gifts, disciple students, lead homegroups and step out in evangelism. We would expect Impact students to join the staff team on a Tuesday morning for a weekly planning meeting, and commit at least 3 further days each week (including Sundays) to getting stuck into various responsibilities within the church. You'll need to find 10-16 hours per week of paid employment in the city to help with rent, living and training costs.

We are looking in particular for Impact students interested in serving in the following areas:

1. Administration

In a growing church with increasing ministries we are always seeking to improve our communication, planning, equipping and resourcing of leaders, midweek training and Celebration Sunday events. You will play a key role in making this happen, getting to grips with the infrastructure of local church and learning a terrific amount in the process. You'll learn to run a website, plan events, process finances, negotiate venue bookings and communicate with vision to leaders and the wider church.

2. Assistant to 0-11s Worker

In response to many new arrivals over the last 2 years, we're in the process of redeveloping our 0-11s ministry. We hope to employ a part-time 0-11s worker from Spring 2012. You will work alongside the 0-11s worker to develop curriculums, plan events, equip leaders and build bridges into the local community. This really is an opportunity to help pioneer a fantastic kids ministry that will impact hundreds of lives over the coming years.

We also know that church life is dynamic and multi-faceted, and you'll have plenty of opportunities to pursue your passions. We're also hoping to collaborate with Exeter YMCA alongside their new year-out scheme... If you've got ideas, get in touch!

When?

Impact is an 11-month project running from September 2012 until July 2013. Applications close Easter 2012.

Wallet?

Impact Training fees are £1095. There is the possibility of joining an overseas mission trip with others at the Bristol training base. This is estimated to cost £400 (Portugal) or £650 (India).

There are various ways to fund an Impact year. In normal circumstances you will need to find a part-time job in Exeter to help finance the year. If you have any questions about finances please come and talk to us.
